Regional Anangu Services Aboriginal Corporation (RASAC) is pleased to announce that our collaboration with TAFE SA to bring quality training and development opportunities to Anangu workers on the Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara (APY) Lands, has been recognised in the SA Training Awards, 2017.

Our submission to the Awards, 'Remote Indigenous Workforce Development - a Collaborative Approach', has been listed as a finalist in the Industry Collaboration Award Category, and highlights the innovative training model that has evolved over many years between RASAC and TAFE SA.

The model is founded on wrap-around training and support for RASAC workers to ensure a culturally and linguistically appropriate program. The model recognises the current skills of Anangu workers, aligns RASAC's in-house training to accredited units of competency and is underpinned by a thorough RPL and skills gap training strategy from TAFE SA.

The collaboration provides a successful workforce development model for adoption by other employers and registered training organisations working in the remote Indigenous community context.

RASAC is very proud to be recognised at these prestigious Awards. The winners in all categories of the Awards will be announced at the SA Training Awards Dinner in Adelaide on Friday 1 September.
