

PUKATJA HISTORIC WINDMILL AND WATER TANK BECOME PERMANENT ART INSTALLATION

RICH IN LOCAL HISTORY, THE WINDMILL AND WATER TANK ARE ICONIC IN FORMING PART OF PUKATJA'S LANDSCAPE. THIS WAS THE FIRST WATER TANK AND WINDMILL BUILT DURING THE EARLY MISSION DAYS. WITH THE CURRENT COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS, SERVICE PROVIDERS AND ART CENTRES HAVE HAD TO FIND NEW WAYS OF DOING THINGS. ERNABELLA ARTS TOOK THEIR STUDIO OUT INTO THE BUSH!

Artists have taken inspiration from surrounding tali (sandhills) that are reflected in the multiple layers of earthy hues.


With CDP activities on pause due to COVID-19 restrictions,
